Proverbs 25:9-15; Ephesians 4:15-16

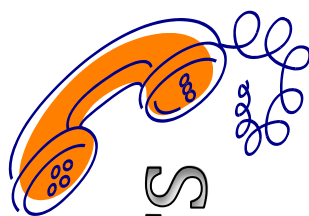
1. *If I have a problem with another person, I will go to him privately.*

PTL (Parent Teacher League) is an organization to which all families of Immanuel Lutheran School belong. The purpose of PTL is to create good communication between parents and school, foster spiritual and family growth, and improve school academic and extra-curricular activities.

EVENTS, AIDS, AND AGENCIES AVAILABLE TO OUR STUDENTS

SCHOOL HOURS this year are from 8:15 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.

Children should arrive between 8:00-8:10 a.m., unless the bus drops them off. They should be picked up as soon as possible at 3:15 p.m. unless they have after school activities or confirmation. Drop-off and pick-up of students is at the Courtyard doors.

EARLY RELEASE:

Wednesdays at 2:00

September 3 through May 20 for the 2025-2026 school year.

TUITION for non-members is \$3,125 per child. There are multi-child discounts: \$100 2nd child, \$300 3rd child, \$1,000 4th child, Free 5th child. Tuition for members is \$2,375. Early Childhood tuition is the same for both members and non-members alike and it is \$1,000 for Preschool (snack included) and \$2,500 for PreK (lunch and snacks included).

SCHOOL PICTURES

Individual school pictures will be taken by Rickers on Tuesday, September 16. Picture Retake Day is Friday, October 10.

SPORTS – Immanuel sponsors boys and girls basketball, girls volleyball, coed softball, and coed soccer. Students are encouraged to participate. Other sports such as golf, wrestling, track, football, cross country, and baseball are available at the public school for boys. Girls may participate in golf, softball, cheerleading, gymnastics, wrestling, cross country, and track.

LEARNING DISABILITIES – Immanuel offers learning disability help through the public school. In order to receive this help, certain testing must be done, with the parent's permission. This would enable the public school to offer students special help with specially trained teachers.

CHAPEL

There is a weekly chapel service for the children on Wednesday morning at 8:20 a.m. Each quarter the offerings will be sent to a mission. The Chapel Offerings for 2025-2026 will go to these missions:

1st Quarter – Lakefield Food Shelf

4th Quarter – Tuition Assistance Program

SPECIAL EVENTS

National Lutheran Schools Week will be January 25-31. All parents are invited and encouraged to visit the classrooms during those days. Parents will have an opportunity to visit with the teachers, see some of their children's schoolwork and other activities.

CHRISTMAS SERVICE

The Christmas Service will be held on Wednesday, December 17. This is a very special event for the children. On this occasion, the opportunity is given to them to tell in the most joyous way possible, the story of Jesus' birth. A reception may follow.

EVENTS, AIDS, AND AGENCIES AVAILABLE TO OUR STUDENTS

BUS TRANSPORTATION – Public school districts in Minnesota are required by law to provide transportation to school for students in their respective districts. If you live outside of the Jackson County Central School District (JCC), transportation is required up to the district line. Once that child reaches a pickup point at the edge of the district line that child will then be transported to Immanuel. An agreement has also been worked out with Heron Lake Okabena School (HLO) to transport students from that district to Immanuel. If you have any questions regarding transportation, please call the school office. Immanuel currently has students from several different school districts – Heron Lake Okabena, Jackson County Central, and Windom. It is impossible therefore, to arrange school days and days off to coincide with all of the different districts. Immanuel will set up a separate calendar, working as closely as possible with area school districts to allow for bus transportation as much as possible. There may be days, however, when some school districts who provide some of our student bussing are not available. If transportation to school on those days is not possible, we will consider it an excused absence. By following our own schedule, we will also be able to get out sooner in May and still have the required number of school days. Snow days may also cause a problem if different schools start late, dismiss early, or do not have school some days. On days when weather affects school, we will follow JCC since most of our students are from this district. If other schools dismiss early or start late due to the weather, we certainly will excuse students from those districts whenever they dismiss or when they arrive due to late starts. We will try to be very flexible in this matter.

Any decision on school closings, early outs, or late starts is sent out right away through FastDirect. After that it is posted on the Immanuel Lutheran School, Lakefield MN Facebook page.

BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Immanuel School, being aware of God's physical blessings upon our students, and the need for good Christian competition among our schools, sponsors one basketball tournament for boys and girls during the month of January. This event takes the cooperation of all parents and students as well as the faculty to be successful. The tournament will be January 30-31.

MUSICAL AND/OR CONCERT

Each year the school performs either a concert or musical for the family of Immanuel and the community of Lakefield. The Christmas service will be held on Wednesday, December 17. A spring concert will be held, date is TBD.

FINE ARTS

Our ILS Fine Arts Festival will be held March 6. The Region IV Fine Arts Festival is March 7 at Martin Luther High School. Participation is optional. Students may choose to participate in one of the following areas: Oral Reading, Musical selections (Vocal or Instrumental), Creative Writing or Science Project (Grades 5-8 only) along with submitting an Art Project. Teachers will be available for suggestions, but it is up to the parents to help their child with their projects. Students and parents are asked to begin working on their projects at least one month in advance.

HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

In the spring of 2024, a survey was sent to all parents to grasp what the desire was for hot lunch versus cold lunch and if we should continue with the state hot lunch program. After consideration of the survey results with much investigation and consideration it was determined that most felt we should get away from the state program, but a hot lunch was preferred over sending a cold lunch everyday.

The mission of the school board is to develop a hot lunch program that would not be state driven. We offer a hot lunch meal 5 days a week and also offer the option for families to bring a cold lunch if preferred.

\$4.00 Hot Lunch meal

\$.50 add Salad Bar to Hot Lunch meal

\$2.75 Salad Bar only

\$2.25 Extra Entree

A Lunch Assistance Program has been established by the school board. A form is sent out with the Back to School mailing.

The last thing the school board wants to do is lose any of our Immanuel families over lunch so if there are concerns or comments reach out to one of them. With that, the lunch program will be reviewed throughout the year to determine that we are where we should be with funds. There will be much work and input needed to make this a success. With the help of PTL, the school board will look to resurrect the hot lunch committee that was done in the past. Please keep all of this activity and consideration in your prayers and if there are any questions and or concerns reach out to our principal or any school board member.

A calendar with the menus comes out the beginning of the month to help you with your menu planning at home. It is sent out through FastDirect.

PreK lunch is included in their tuition amount.

Payment for the lunch program should be done in advance by check payable to "Immanuel Hot Lunch". Please keep Hot Lunch money separate from other school monies.

We strongly encourage prompt payments so that bills may be paid on time.

SPELLING BEE

The Spelling Bee will be held April 25 at Truman.

Participation is decided through "spell-off" with students chosen to attend as delegates and alternate delegates.

CHESS TOURNAMENT

Our Immanuel chess tournament will be on Saturday, March 14. Chess Club here at Immanuel is for students in grades Kindergarten-8th.

**CONSTITUTION OF THE PARENT-TEACHERS' LEAGUE OF
IMMANUEL LUTHERAN SCHOOL, LAKEFIELD, MN**

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Parent – Teachers' League of Immanuel Lutheran School, Lakefield, MN.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

To further Christian Education at Immanuel and sister congregations

To increase interest in our Christian Day School Confirmation instructions and Sunday School.

To foster Christian fellowship for our parents and teachers.

To promote Christian relationships between parents and teachers.

ARTICLE III

All parents with children enrolled in Immanuel Lutheran Christian Day School, and all Christian Day School teachers, are considered members of PTL. Each member shall receive a copy of the PTL Constitution and Bylaws, as revised.

ARTICLE IV

The Constitution and by-laws of the organization may be amended by a 2/3 vote at a regular meeting provided that notice of proposed amendment has been read at previous meeting.

BY – LAWS

ARTICLE I

The organization meets once a month throughout the school year for a meeting and/or an activity. Business meetings will be held the first Thursday at 7:00 PM. Times and dates for events or activities are scheduled before the beginning of each school year.

ARTICLE II

Those present at any regular meeting or special meeting shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE III

All members of PTL are invited and encouraged to attend all meetings and activities.

ARTICLE IV

Executive Board

The Executive Board of the PTL shall consist of the elected President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Member at Large and the school Principal. The Principal of the Christian Day School shall be an ex-officio member of all PTL committees and shall assist in planning programs and engaging speakers.

ARTICLE V

Officer Duties –

President: The President shall preside at all meetings and be an ex-officio member of all committees. The president may call special meetings.

Vice-President: The Vice-President shall perform all duties of the President during the President's absence or at the request of the President.

Secretary: The Secretary shall record all minutes and conduct all correspondence.

Treasurer: The Treasurer shall collect all monies, keep an accurate record of all disbursements, and shall render monthly reports, and an annual report, and shall have all books ready for an annual audit.

Member at Large: shall represent the voting members of PTL.

ARTICLE VI

Nomination for elections

The Executive Board shall be responsible for obtaining candidates for ballot elections of officers.

ARTICLE VII

Election of Officers

The election of officers shall be held at the regular meeting in March, or at regular meetings as soon thereafter as

possible. All elections shall be by ballot. Members receiving a majority of votes for each office shall be declared duly elected. The terms of new officers shall begin with the commencement of the next school year immediately following the year in which they were elected.

ARTICLE VIII

Elections of Officers of the By-Laws –

President: The President shall be elected for one two-year term in each even numbered year.

Vice-President: The Vice-President shall be elected for one two year term in each odd numbered year.

Secretary: The Secretary shall be elected for one two-year term in each odd-numbered year.

Treasurer: The Treasurer shall be elected for one two-year term in each even numbered year.

Member at Large: One member of the Executive Board shall be elected for one two-year term in each even numbered year.

ARTICLE IX

Athletic Tournament Directors: Election and Duties

Tournament directors shall be elected each year from the membership to assist the Athletic Director with all aspects of the Immanuel Basketball Tournament, except food services.

ARTICLE X

Athletic Director and Athletic Program Funding

The Athletic Director shall be appointed by the Immanuel Lutheran School Board of Christian Education and by the school principal. The Athletic Program shall be funded by the PTL treasury.

ARTICLE XI

Athletic Director Duties

The Athletic Director shall be responsible for scheduling sports activities throughout the year. The Athletic Director is responsible for inviting other teams to participate in Immanuel Lutheran School athletic tournaments. The Director will be responsible for securing referees, as needed.

ARTICLE XII

Basketball Tournament Food Committee

The Food Committee shall consist of 3 families. The committee is responsible for the food menu, purchasing food and food items, preparing and serving food during the tournament, and cleanup. The Food Committee shall be assisted by PTL members. The committee is responsible for scheduling volunteers to help during the tournament.
